

PHILIPPINES

The Philippines lies strategically within the arc of nations that sweeps southeastward from mainland Asia to Australia.

The country is an archipelago with over 7,100 islands, many of which are remote and referred to as GIDAs (geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas). The islands are home to over 11 million indigenous peoples belonging to over 110 ethno-linguistic groups.
